## KIND's Presence at the First Production Ceremony of Polimery Police PDH/PP Plant in Poland

Korea Overseas Infrastructure and Urban Development Corporation (KIND, CEO Kanghoon Lee) announced its participation in the First Production Ceremony of the Polimery Police PDH/PP Plant project in Szczecin, Poland, on June 22nd.

The Polimery Police PDH/PP plant, the largest petrochemical project in Poland at the time(approximately 1.2 billion USD), is the project that KIND and Hyundai Engineering have invested together as a 'Team Korea' . The project was commenced in August, 2019. The construction period is 49 months and the commercial operation is set to begin in September of this year.

The PDH/PP plant is a facility that produces polypropylene(PP), which is thermoplastic polymer used in various industries, including packaging, automotive parts and textiles. The PP produced from this project is intended to be sold in domestic market in Poland and also exported to the neighboring European markets.

The ceremony was graced by the presence of Mateusz Morawiecki, Polish Prime Minister and Tomasz Hinc, CEO of Grupa Azoty. Notable attendees at the ceremony also included Hoonmin Lim, the ambassador of Republic of Korea, and Hyeonsung Hong, CEO of Hyundai Engineering.

At the Ceremony, Kanghoon Lee, the President of KIND, delivered a congratulatory speech. He expressed “It is highly meaningful to KIND that the project we’ve invested in the early stage of its establishment finally achieved the milestone, in our 5th anniversary year, 2023.” . Also he highlighted, “As KIND has signed an MOU with Polish Investment and Trade Agency(PAIIH), we’ll make further efforts to enhance economic cooperation with Korea and Poland.” KIND will continue to support Korean companies to expand their market into Europe by participating in projects related to Poland or Ukraine’s restoration.
