
*Procurement with a period of 2-8 months can be carried out as long as the preparation documents and supporting documents are ready to be confirmed

**Financing fulfillment can be extended a maximum of 2 times and each extension is carried out within a period of 6 months



Simplification of Unsolicited PPP Process

In implementing an unsolicited PPP, there is a simplification of the process where at the beginning of the Unsolicited process there is no longer a need to prepare a pre-feasibility study but it is necessary to submit an LOI accompanied by supporting documents. Then, after approval, the process continues with the proposal of the initiative accompanied by a Feasibility Study (FS).





Delegation of Authority

Ministry/Head of Institution

- The delegation of authority is determined by the minister/head of institution

Delegation of Authority does not transfer the responsibility of the minister/instituti on head/regional head as PJPK

District Head

- The regional head as PJPK can delegate authority to the regional secretary or head of regional apparatus whose scope, duties and responsibilities cover the infrastructure sector in accordance with the provisions of statutory regulations.



- Delegation of Authority does not include: signing PPP Agreements, regression agreements and/or other agreements which are the responsibility of regional heads in implementing PPP projects.
- The delegation of authority is determined by District head.



Duties and Parties of the Process Advisor

- Responsible for providing recommendations to the GCA regarding the suitability of the PPP project process from BUP procurement to financing fulfilment. If necessary, it can be involved from the PPP preparation stage.
- Can come from business entities, individuals, and/or government internal supervision apparatus (APIP).



Transaction Stage

- Can be involved by the GCA in the PPP transaction stage to assist the GCA in carrying out the process: Procurement of Implementing Business Entities, Signing of the PPP Agreement and Fulfilment of financing

Preparation Stage

Can be involved by the GCA in the PPP preparation stage to assist the GCA in implementing the process:
Preparation of BUP Procurement
Documents, Preparation of PPP
Agreement, Exploring Market
Interest, Other activities related to the implementation of BUP
Procurement and fulfilment of financing carried out at the preparation stage

The formation is regulated in Bappenas Ministerial Regulation No. 7 of 2023

The **formation** was carried out **by Bappenas** with the following criteria:

- adequate skill competency, intensity and capacity to work on PPP projects;
- experience working on and/or assisting projects in similar sectors;
- **best risk management** that can be offered to the GCA;
- other criteria

Active

Done actively, for example by inviting agencies/institutions/inte rnational organization to submit proposals

Passive

This can be done passively, for example if there are several international agencies/institutions/organizations who express their interest in facilitating assistance for PPP projects including the type of sector or infrastructure of interest.





- Simple structure or scope,

- Preferably does not require feasibility support as proven , including the GCA's fiscal capacity to implement the p roject

Proses Simplification

- Simpler study documents.
- Can form or use a limited liabili ty company that was establishe d before the Procurement of the PPP Implementing Business Entity began to act as the Implementing Business Entity.
- For local governments, the cooperation period is limited to a maximum of 10 years



Transition of PPP Initiatives (Solicited → Unsolicited)

PPP Initiative Transition: Solicited → **Unsolicited**

The transition at the transaction level is done when the Procurement of the Implementing Agency fails and the PJPK declares the termination of the Procurement of the Implementing Agency



Planning Stage

- The GCA evaluates the need for transition to PPP initiatives and the proposed Business Entity initiative



Preparation and Transaction Stage (GCA Does):

- Evaluation of the transition needs of PPP initiatives
- Assessment of feasibility studies and supporting documents
- Compare the Pre-FS produced by the GCA with the FS and supporting documents produced by the Business Entity

Consideration of Transitioning Solicited to Unsolicited



In comparing the Pre-Qualification Study produced by GCA with FS and Supporting documents from businesses, GCA considers the added value that provides the least:

- More Innovative New Elements
- -Better VfM
- Better economic and financial qualification

Preparation Stage

Transition can be done when the Candidate Initiator resigns



Transaction Stage (A transition can be made when):

- The initiator withdraws before the stage of implementation of the Procurement of the Executing Agency begins; or
- The Procurement of the Executing Agency failed and PJPK announced the termination of the Executing Agency Procurement.



Establishment of SPC To PPP Procurement

Changes to the PPP Agreement after Signing

Changes to the contents of the PPP Agreement can be made based on the agreement of the GCA and the Implementing Business Entity with the provisions not to make changes


Changes to the contents of the PPP Agreement are made to comply with government policies or statutory regulations

Changes to the contents of the Agreement ensure that the internal rate of return does not change, specifically for changes to the contents of the PPP agreement which result in changes to risk feasibility and/or offering parameters

Several provisions must be proven if the GCA and the Implementing Business Entity need to change provisions that cannot be changed



Financial Close Period Limitations



- In PPN Ministerial Decree 7/2023 it is regulat ed regarding financial closer restrictions which has not previously been set on PPN Ministerial Decree 4/2015 jo Ministerial Decree 2/2020
- It is hoped that the limitation on the extension of the financial close will provide certainty to the GCA regarding the process of fulfilling the financing carried out by BUP and the continuation of the PPP project being implemented.

Transitional Provisions

When this ministerial regulation applies:

Transition Provision for PPP Stage

- GCA which is implementing the stages of PPP before the implementation of Bappenas Ministerial Regulation No 7/2023, then GCA must completed the stage s and fulfills completion of PPP documents in accordance with provision of Bappenas Ministerial Regulations No 4/2015 jo No 2/2020.
- To continue the next stage, GCA implements the PPP stage in accordance with the provisions of Bappenas Ministerial Regulation No 7/2023
- If there are requirements for the next stage, then GCA completes the requirements in accordance with the provisions of Bappenas Ministerial Regulation No 7/2023

When this ministerial regulation applies :

Transition Provision for BUMD

- The KPBU agreement that has been signed by the BUMD board of directors is stated to remain in effect
- PPP projects that are currently in the transaction stage, the BUMD board of directors completes and extends the stage in accordance with PPN Ministerial Regulation 4/2015 Jo 2/2020
- PPP projects that have not yet entered into a transaction complete the implementation stages in accordance with PPN Ministerial Regulation 4/2015 Jo 2/2020 and continue the next stage with the new Ministerial Regulation. In completing the stage of the project that has not yet entered into the transaction, the District Head issues an assignment to BUMD in accordance with the provisions of the new Bappenas Ministerial Regulation No 7/2023
